## Fees and registration

Tuition: \$525 per session, plus a non-refundable \$25 registration fee. Registration with payment must be postmarked on or before **April 16 for the May 17–21 workshop** and on or before **May 28 for all other workshops**. If registering after these dates, add a \$25 late fee. All amounts payable in U.S. dollars.
